Human Papillomavirus (HPV) is a common infection that is often undiagnosed. By helping prevent infection with HPV, the risk of developing cervical cancer may be reduced.

The Keogh Institute for Medical Research is inviting healthy young women to enrol in a trial which is investigating a new vaccine to help prevent infection with certain types of HPV.

You could be eligible to participate if:-

- you are a healthy young woman aged 18-26
- have no history of gynaecological problems and
- are able to make about 12 visits to
The Keogh Institute over a 36 month period



You will be assisting in a research program which may improve a major health problem for women. Participants will be financially reimbursed for their time and inconvenience.
